Customs Brokers Licensing Management System (CBLMS).

Customs Brokers Licensing Management System (CBLMS) has been operationalised and registration of CB Profiles and their validation is under process. It has been noticed that there has been some confusion among stakeholders regarding CB profile registration applications which have been submitted to the incorrect Parent Policy Section as CBLMS does not allow the change in Parent Policy Section by way of deficiency feature. In few of such cases, the Customs Brokers have submitted CB Profile Registration Applications by selecting the Parent Policy Section as per Policy Section code reflected in ICES.

In this regard, it is clarified that

1. For the purpose of CBLMS, the Parent Policy Section for a Customs Broker is that Commissionerate of Customs which has granted the Customs Brokers License under Regulation 7(2) of CBLR, 2018 or under the respective provisions of the erstwhile regulations. In cases where the original Policy Section Commissionerate, which issued the CB License, has been discontinued or merged with any other Commissionerate then the Parent Policy Section would be the Policy Section (Customs Brokers Section) of that Commissionerate which is presently maintaining the said issued CB License file of the Customs Broker.
2. In ICES, there are many instances where one Policy Section make the Customs Broker entries for the CB Licenses issued by multiple Policy Sections. For example, INBOM1 make Customs Broker entries in ICES for the CB Licenses issued by Mumbai Customs (General) Policy Section as well as for the CB Licenses issued by Pune Customs Policy Section.

However, for the purpose of CBLMS, all Customs Brokers must be advised to select the Parent Policy Section as per para (1) above.

3. For cases where the CB has already submitted the CB profile registration application with incorrect Parent Policy Section, following procedure is to be adopted by the CBs and Policy Section to whom the CB has wrongly submitted the CB profile registration application:

a. The Policy Section Officer who has received and is processing the CB Profile registration application with incorrect Parent Policy Section should reject such application with suitable remarks indicating that the Parent Policy Section is not correct. CB will be notified by the system about the rejection of the application.

b. After rejection of such application with incorrect Policy Section, an option to fill and submit the fresh CB profile registration application will be made available in the accounts of such Customs Brokers in the upcoming new release of CBLMS which is expected by 02.12.2022. Customs Brokers will use this option to fill the CB Profile Registration Application again with the correct Parent Policy Section.
