Sub: Conduct of G-category examination for the year 2024 under Regulation 13(5) of CBLR, 2018 by Commissionerate of Customs (Preventive), West Bengal- Reg.

Kind attention is invited to all the stakeholders that this office will be conducting a written examination on **19.02.2024** for issuance of G-card under Regulation 13 (5) of the Customs Brokers Licensing Regulations, 2018 for existing “H” Card holders as on 30.01.2024. Only four attempts are allowed from the date of appointment as ‘H’ card holder, as per regulation 13(5) of CBLR, 2018.

2. EXAMINATION MODE AND OTHER RELEVANT DETAILS

i. The applications for the aforesaid examination have to be made only through online mode on the CBLMS portal (<https://cblms.gov.in>) under the tab Examination/ G-category Examinations/ Kolkata Customs (Preventive) by clicking on Apply.

ii. A User Manual with the name “User manual for G Category Examination Application” is available on CBLMS portal (<http://cblms.gov.in>) incorporating the steps to be followed by the applicants for getting registered as a ‘New User’. Desirous candidates are requested to follow the instructions contained in the User Manual carefully to avoid any errors/ mis-declarations in the applications.

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iii. The CBLMS portal will be active for accepting applications for the examination from 01.02.2024 till 07.02.2024 (18:00 hrs.) only. After scrutiny of the applications, a list of eligible candidates will be displayed on or before 09.02.2024 on the websites & <http://cblms.gov.in> as well as on the notice board. Admit cards to the eligible candidates will be issued through the CBLMS portal from **12.02.2024 to 15.02.2024**.

iv. Before submitting the application, the applicant must ensure the correctness/completeness of the details filled in the application.

v. Nowhere any application form in manual mode shall be received in the Commissionerate.

3. PAYMENT OF FEES:

Scan copy of the TR-6 Challan/Bills for Miscellaneous Charges of Rs. 500/- as 'Examination Fee' paid in favour of the Commissioner of Customs (Preventive), West Bengal (A/c No. 30277239121, IFSC Code-SBIN0000001) has to be uploaded in the application form as explained in the User Manual.

4 . DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED ALONGWITH THE APPLICATION:

I. Copy of H Card issued by the Commissionerate of Customs (Preventive), West Bengal.

II. TR-6 Challan/Bills for Miscellaneous Charges.

III. Self-declaration regarding no. Of attempts (Annexure-A attached).

5. EXAMINATION DETAILS AND PAPER PATTERN:

I. The G-Card examination will be of 02 hour duration written examination in the form of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) of total 300 marks and the minimum qualifying marks will be 180 i.e 60% of total marks. The examination shall be such as to ascertain the adequacy of knowledge of such person regarding the provisions of Acts/Rules/Regulations subject to which goods and baggage are cleared through Customs. Results of the written examination will be declared on **27.02.2024** over the websites <https://cblms.gov.in> & <https://kolkatacustoms.gov.in> and on the notice board as well.

II. The written examination will be conducted on 19.02.2024 in offline mode. Venue and time of exam will be mentioned on the Admit Card, which

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will be accessible to the applicants through their login credentials on CBLMS Portal from **12.02.2024 to 15.02.2024**. The venue and time may also be confirmed from the departmental website <https://kolkatacustoms.gov.in> and www.cblms.gov.in. The pattern of the examination will be as follows:

No. Of questions: 100

Marking Scheme: +3 for each correct answer -1 for each incorrect answer

Maximum Marks: 300

Qualifying Marks: 180 (60% of the maximum marks)

6. DOCUMENTS TO BE CARRIED AT EXAMINATION CENTRES:

All eligible candidates shall bring their valid 'H' Card, Admit card and Aadhar Card on the examination date to their respective examination Centre/Hall, failing which they shall not be permitted to appear in the examination.

7. ADVISORY FOR APPLICANTS FOR USE OF UNFAIR MEANS AND MIS-STATEMENT OF INFORMATION:

i. Use of unfair means in the examination is strictly prohibited and action shall be taken against persons found indulging in unfair practices as permitted under law;

ii. It may be noted that if any suppression or wilful misstatements of any factual or material information in the application is noticed at any stage even after declaration of the result, the candidate shall be treated as disqualified from the examination and, in addition, will also be liable to appropriate action under the provision of CBLR, 2018/or any other law for the time being in force.

The decision of the Assistant Commissioner of Customs (Technical), Commissionerate of Customs (Preventive), West Bengal shall be final in all respects for the examination.
